

District VI Annual Report

District VI (1922) consists of two clubs, New Glasgow (1925) and Truro (1960) with a total membership of 62 Gyros with strong support of Gyrettes/ Lady Gyros at meetings and social functions.

The New Glasgow Club held a number of in-person meetings and an in-person Founders' Night during the year as well as a number of executive meetings via Zoom. The Truro Club held two in-person executive meetings, but has not met as a club since February, 2020.

The New Glasgow Club published 2 Bulletins and the Truro Club published 10 Bulletins.

The New Glasgow Club financially supports two projects in the community.

Both clubs have not added any new members and are concerned with membership decline and the lack of enthusiasm of members to accept leadership positions.

With the movement of people to Nova Scotia from other provinces and states there may be an opportunity for Gyro to provide a Social Connection to their new Community.
