

RESTRUCTURE IMPLEMENTATION TIMELINE

As of September 11, 2025

October 1, 2024	Membership approved restructuring proposal to eliminate a vice-president and eliminate District governance by creating 3 Districts with the District Governors to sit on the Executive Council. This meant there would only be one fee for membership. Implementation proposed to be within 2 years.
June 7, 2025	Annual General Meeting (AGM) approved a revised Constitution and By- Laws with a change in effective date from the 2026 AGM to April 30, 2026.
August 22, 2025	The Executive Council (EC) passed a motion to change the effective date back to immediately after the 2026 AGM.
January 1, 2026	Shortly after January 1 a District Governor Nomination Chairman is appointed by the Secretary-Treasurer in each of the three Districts.
February 1, 2026	On or about February 1 a District Governor Election Chairman is appointed by the Secretary-Treasurer in each of the three Districts.
April 30, 2026	District Governor elections conclude on or prior to this date. However, the current 9 District Governors retain their offices until the end of the 2026 AGM at the 2026 Convention in Calgary.
June 1, 2026	by June 1 a notice of the 2026 AGM and copies of agenda, resolutions, financial statement etc. are forwarded to clubs so they are informed to be able to send a delegate to vote on their behalf.
July 14, 2026	Board of Governor's meeting at the Convention.
July 16, 2026	AGM at the Convention where the President and Vice-President are elected.
July 16, 2026	Immediately following the AGM the revised Constitution and By-Laws approved at the June 7, 2025, AGM are in effect.
July 16, 2026	Installation ceremony for President, Vice-President, Immediate Past President and three District Governors as members of the EC.
July 17, 2026	The new Executive Council has a transition meeting.
September 1, 2026	Creation of District Advisory Committees composed of a representative from each club should be complete or in progress to liaison with the District Governor in each of the new three Districts.
